LOW-INCOME ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Fountain Hills Sanitary District offers a Low-Income Assistance Program to qualifying residents. The program is designed to assist low-income homeowners with utility costs. Eligible homeowners will receive a 25% discount on the quarterly sewer service fee.

To qualify, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a U.S. Citizen or legal resident.
- Be a full-time resident in Fountain Hills.
- The account must be in the homeowner's name, not a renter's.
- Home must be the primary residence.
- Household income does not exceed 150% federal poverty guidelines.

Approved applicants must renew eligibility annually. This program is limited to 100 residential accounts and is not available for commercial or non-residential accounts.

The Sanitary District has partnered with Maricopa County's utility assistance program for low-income residents. The program is administered locally by the Tempe Community Action Agency (TCAA), which serves residents of Fountain Hills. TCAA offers a variety of programs and may be able to assist with multiple utility bills. For more information, contact TCAA: 2146 E Apache Blvd, Tempe, AZ 85281, (480) 422-8922.

The Sanitary District will not collect personal financial records or determine financial eligibility; rather, it will honor eligibility determinations made by other agencies.

There are two ways to demonstrate eligibility:

1. Provide proof of enrollment in another utility's low-income program (i.e., EPCOR, SRP, or Southwest Gas), or
2. Documentation from TCAA verifying program enrollment or eligibility.
